**Question:**

**Response:**

1. Council could specify the streets, noting we have not done that for either the Christmas Festival or BellBeats, however I do not consider it necessary. If there are unforeseen negative consequences we could liaise with police and adjust for following years. If Council does decide to specify the streets and times for this event, then to be consistent we should also look at doing the same for the other events however, as stated, I do not consider that necessary at this time.
2. I am not sure. On reflection I would suggest it is for the 24 hours of the day on which the event is being held ie starts and ends at midnight.
